Medication	Patient Age	Protocol or Rx Only
All immunizations / vaccinations (flu, zoster, tetanus, pertussis, etc.)	7 years and older	Protocol or Rx

Scope of practice expansion, effective July 2019: Act 652 (Representatives Jimmy Gazaway and Robin Lundstrum): An act to amend the definition of "Practice of Pharmacy" to allow vaccines and immunizations to be given to a person from seven (7) years of age to eighteen (18) years of age under a general written protocol; and for other purposes.
