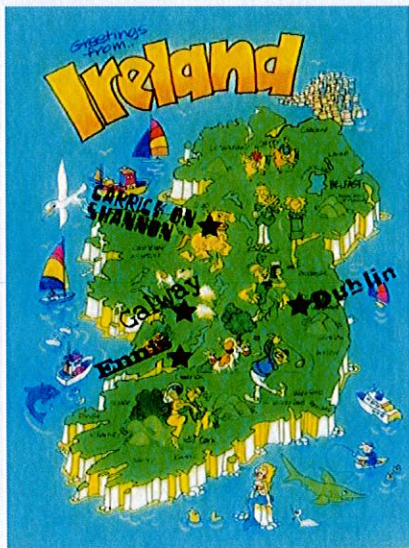

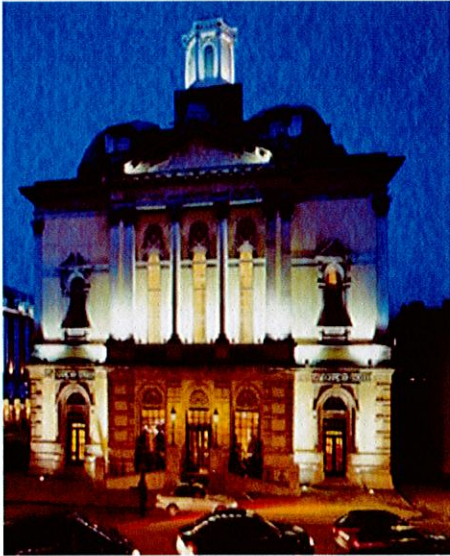

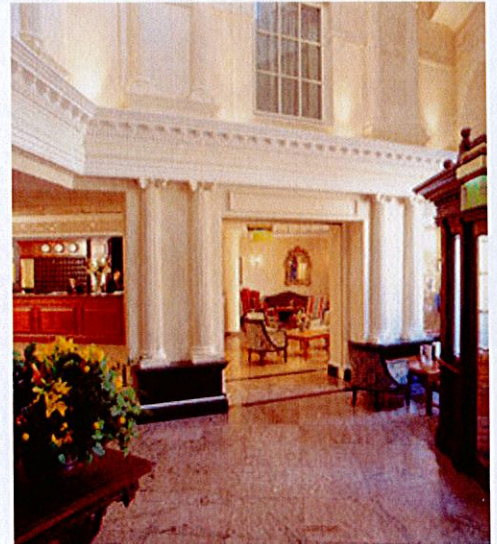
Saturday July 14th to Saturday July 21st 2012

Day 1: Arrive Dublin Airport. Flight details TBA.

Meet & greet by tour guide & driver who will accompany the group throughout the programme. Check-in to the O'Callaghan Davenport Hotel located within walking distance of many pubs and restaurants.



The O'Callaghan Davenport Hotel is a traditional elegant hotel with a historic facade that dates back to 1863. It is a well known Dublin landmark located in central Dublin 2 within strolling distance of Grafton Street, Merrion Square and Trinity College. This excellent 4 star hotel in Dublin is beautifully appointed with polished woods, marble and leather upholstery.



This evening enjoy a buffet dinner in the Gandon Suite of the Hotel.

Day 2: Following breakfast begin with a morning continuing education session in the Gandon



Suite of the Hotel. Following lunch, at leisure, you will be, accompanied by your tour guide to enjoy a tour of Dublin City Historic Tour visiting Trinity College, home of the famous Book of Kells, a fascination, richly decorated text book written in 800 AD.

Next stop is St. Patrick's Cathedral. In 1991 St. Patrick's Cathedral celebrated 800 years of worship.

Since disestablishment, it has been the National Cathedral for the whole of Ireland. The Cathedral welcomes over 300,000 visitors each year. The glory of the building and its many monuments make this place of worship very unique. Stop enroute to enjoy an Irish Coffee, at the Brazen Head in Ireland's oldest pub. Return to Davenport Hotel for an evening at leisure, choose from the many pubs & restaurants in Dublin City.



Day 3: Today your private motorcoach and tour guide are at your disposal for touring. We suggest a tour to the North Coast of Dublin. Drive along the North Dublin Coast, towards **Malahide Castle**, which is set on 250 acres of park land and served as both a fortress & private home for nearly 800 years. The Talbot family lived here from 1185-1973.

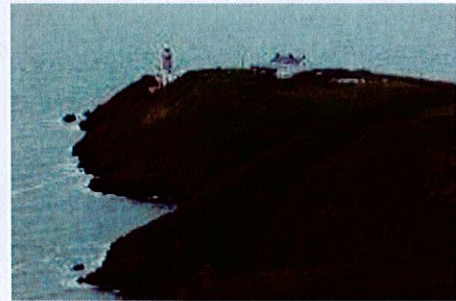


Guests will take a private self-guided tour through the Castle, which is one of Ireland's oldest & most historic locations with an excellent collection of period furniture & Irish oil portraits, mainly from the National Gallery. The medieval Great Hall is the only one in Ireland that is preserved in its original form. Step outside the Castle for a tour of the Talbot Botanic Gardens.

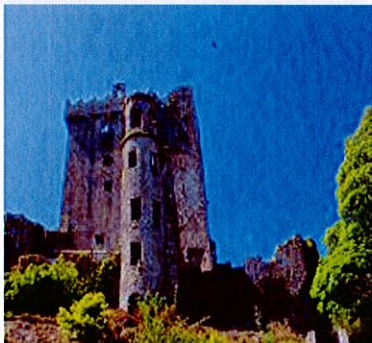
Depart Malahide Castle and drive towards **Howth Marina**. Along the way you will pass magnificent coastal scenery and arrive in Howth, crossing the nearby summit of Howth Head where you will have a panoramic view of Dublin Bay. You may take a leisurely stroll out to the lighthouse to get a closer look at Ireland's Eye and enjoy the slow pace of this quaint little village.

An excellent afternoon for leisure shopping in nearby Nassau and Grafton Streets and to explore your surroundings!

This evening is at leisure, choose from the many pubs & restaurants in Dublin City before returning to the Davenport Hotel.



Day 4:



Following breakfast depart for a visit to **Blarney Castle**.

The 15th century Castle which is famous for its stone, is traditionally believed to have the power to bestow eloquence on all those who kiss it. The stone itself is set in the wall below the battlements and to kiss it, one has to lean backwards (holding on to an iron railing) from the parapet walk. Enjoy shopping time and lunch at leisure in Blarney Woollen Mills before we continue to the picturesque town of Killarney.

Check in to **Killarney Plaza Hotel**.

Day 5:

Day 6:

Day 7:

Continue, accompanied by your tour guide, to the coast of West Clare, where the famous **Cliffs of Moher** defiantly stand as giant natural ramparts against the aggressive might of the Atlantic Ocean. They rise in places to over 700 feet and stretch for almost 5 miles. **Atlantic Edge** is the exciting new interpretive centre now open at the Cliffs of Moher.

Continue to the Burren Region. The Burren is a limestone plateau - a stony chaos to the casual observer - with a full Assemblage of the curious landforms that characterize such limestone landscapes.

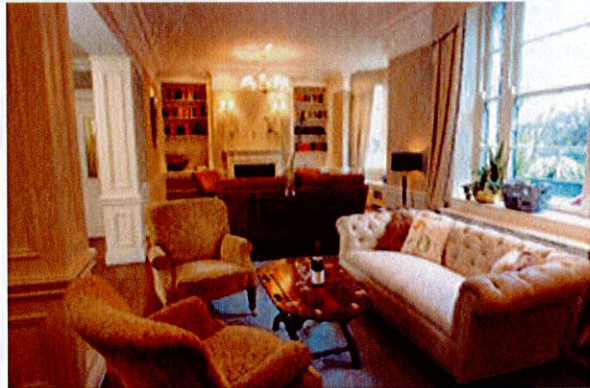


Today's tour will end with check-in at the Old Ground Hotel in Ennis.
